

Low water on the Slaney, just a few fish being caught

The Slaney Valley has still had no rain resulting in a very low river. Anglers at Enniscorthy are still catching a few salmon but even here salmon are becoming reluctant to take. Two anglers amongst the action at Enniscorthy included Tiernan Sluuds who had a fresh 11 pound fish while Shane Sinnott lost three salmon during the week. Shane also caught a number of good sea trout.

Ian Fox, fishing up-river, did manage to catch 2 salmon at Strahart and Kevin Clayton lost three fish at Clohamon on Sunday fishing a Collie Dog. With dry warm weather forecast over the coming week, attention will move to the Sea Trout department. Sea trout have already been caught at Enniscorthy and it shouldn't be long before we see the first batch running the river.
