

SCALE OF THE 2016 FLOODS

While nothing like the Shannon and remembering the impact on Enniscorthy this view of a man cleaning the gauge on 4 August 2013 as compared to this morning 7 January 2016 gives you a feel for the amount of water in the river after recent floods. The 7 Jan view is at least a foot lower than the peak flood. The top of the gauge is just showing
